HALOS Spring Festival



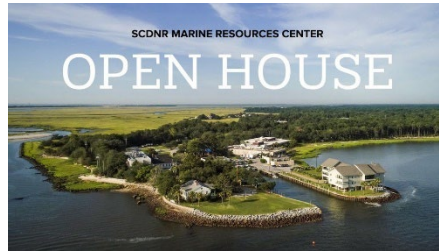
Rotarian Chris Burrell and his son Griffin volunteered at the HALOS Spring Festival on Saturday, April 1st.
